Mr. Roberts reported that the state testing dates have been established with ELA being April 7 – April 23 and math, science and history being April 14 – May 7.

Mr. Reuter reported that the spelling bee was held. First place was Carter Risner, second place was Connor McGlone, third place was Reeselynn Shanks and fourth place was Xerik Curry. At the county spelling bee, Reeselynn Shanks was the top Piketon speller. Mr. Reuter expressed gratitude to his staff for their flexibility on the early dismissal day due to snow.
